BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - Transportation** 4 21 1207.2. 5 (A)IN THIS SECTION, 6 11-154.1. 7 "SCOOTER" MEANS A TWO-WHEELED VEHICLE THAT: 8 (1) HAS TWO WHEELS AND HANDLEBARS; AND 9 (2) IS DESIGNED TO BE OPERATED: 10 <del>(I)</del> BY A SEATED RIDER; OR 11 (II)BY A RIDER STANDING ON A LOW FOOTBOARD BETWEEN THE 12 TWO WHEELS; AND 13 **IS PROPELLED BY:** (3)14  $\overline{\mathbf{H}}$ AN ELECTRIC OR GASOLINE MOTOR; OR 15 (II)THE RIDER PUSHING ONE FOOT AGAINST THE GROUND WHILE 16 RESTING THE OTHER FOOT ON THE FOOTBOARD. 17 <del>(B)</del> A PERSON STOOD ON BY THE OPERATOR. 18 21-1207.2. 19 AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY NOT RIDE ON A (A) 20 SCOOTER OR ON IN-LINE SKATES ON ANY HIGHWAY, BICYCLE WAY, SIDEWALK, OR 21 OTHER PROPERTY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC OR USED BY THE PUBLIC FOR PEDESTRIAN 22 <u>OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, UNLESS THE PERSON INDIVIDUAL</u> IS WEARING A HELMET 23 THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE STANDARDS OF THE AMERICAN NATIONAL 24 STANDARDS INSTITUTE, THE SNELL MEMORIAL FOUNDATION'S STANDARD, OR THE 25 STANDARDS OF FOUNDATION, OR THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF TESTING AND 26 MEASUREMENTS FOR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR FOR USE IN BICYCLING OR IN-LINE 27 SKATING. THIS SECTION SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE ISSUANCE OF A 28 <del>(C)</del> 29 WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION 30 AND PROVIDES EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS ABOUT HELMET USE. 31 SECTION 2.
