1 AN ACT concerning
2 Child Passenger Safety Technicians <u>and Sponsoring Organizations</u> - Qualified Immunity from Civil Liability
FOR the purpose of providing immunity from civil liability for child passenger safety technicians and sponsoring organizations for acts and omissions that occur solely in the inspection ex, installation, or adjustment of a child safety seat in a motor vehicle, or in giving certain advice or assistance under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to qualified immunity from civil liability for child passenger safety technicians and sponsoring organizations.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (2) "CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL
 2 WHO HAS BEEN CERTIFIED HOLDS A CURRENT CERTIFICATION AS A CHILD
 3 PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIAN OR TECHNICIAN INSTRUCTOR BY THE NATIONAL

 5 OF TRANSPORTATION, THE AMERICAN AUTOMOBILE ASSOCIATION, OR OTHER

- 8 (3) "CHILD SAFETY SEAT" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 22-412.2 OF 9 THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.
- 10 (4) "SPONSORING ORGANIZATION" MEANS A PERSON THAT:
- 11 <u>(I) EMPLOYS A CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIAN;</u>
- 12 (II) OFFERS OR ARRANGES FREE CHILD SAFETY SEAT CHECKUP
- 13 EVENTS OR FITTING STATION PROGRAMS FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC; OR
- 14 (III) OWNS PROPERTY ON WHICH A FREE CHILD SAFETY SEAT
- 15 CHECKUP EVENT OR FITTING STATION PROGRAM FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC TAKES

- 17 (B) A CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIAN OR SPONSORING
- 18 ORGANIZATION IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR AN ACT OR OMISSION THAT OCCURS
- 19 SOLELY IN THE INSPECTION OR, INSTALLATION, OR ADJUSTMENT OF A CHILD
- 20 SAFETY SEAT IN A MOTOR VEHICLE, OR IN GIVING ADVICE OR ASSISTANCE
- 21 REGARDING THE INSTALLATION OR ADJUSTMENT OF A CHILD SAFETY SEAT, IF:
- 22 (1) THE CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIAN ACTS IN GOOD FAITH
- 23 AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE TRAINING FOR WHICH THE TECHNICIAN IS
- 24 CURRENTLY CERTIFIED;
- 25 (2) THE ACT OR OMISSION DOES NOT CONSTITUTE GROSS NEGLIGENCE
- 26 OR WILLFUL OR WANTON MISCONDUCT; AND
- 27 (3) THE INSPECTION OR, INSTALLATION, OR ADJUSTMENT OF THE
- 28 CHILD SAFETY SEAT, OR THE ADVICE OR ASSISTANCE, IS PROVIDED WITHOUT FEE OR
- 29 CHARGE TO THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 31 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 32 on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.
- 33 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 34 October 1, 2001.
