14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 19	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "UNIT" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT:
20 21	(1) A STANDING COMMITTEE AS DEFINED IN § 2-101(F) OF THIS TITLE OR A SUBCOMMITTEE OF A STANDING COMMITTEE;

- 1 (2) A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY STATUTE OR A 2 SUBCOMMITTEE OF A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE;
- 3 (3) THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR A SPECIAL COMMITTEE 4 APPOINTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE UNDER § 2-407(B)(3) OF THIS 5 TITLE; OR
- 6 (4) ANY OTHER TASK FORCE OR COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE 7 LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE HOUSE OR 8 SENATE.
- 9 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO HEARINGS OR OTHER PROCEEDINGS OF A 10 UNIT THAT ARE REQUIRED TO BE RECORDED BY THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OR 11 SENATE.
- 12 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT, IN A MATTER WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF A UNIT, 13 KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY:
- 14 (1) FALSIFY OR CONCEAL A MATERIAL FACT;
- 15 (2) MAKE A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION; OR
- 16 (3) MAKE OR USE A DOCUMENT THAT CONTAINS A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, 17 OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION.
- 18 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 19 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR
- 20 IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
