2 Election Law - Campaign Accounts - Administrative Closure

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Elections to close a campaign
- 4 account based on a finding that good cause and certain other criteria exist;
- 5 providing that closing a campaign account does not affect certain legal liabilities
- of individuals associated with a campaign account; and generally relating to
- 7 closing campaign accounts.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A-2) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A-1) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE
- 18 BOARD MAY CLOSE A CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT UPON A DETERMINATION THAT GOOD
- 19 CAUSE EXISTS AND THAT:
- 20 (I) AN OFFICER AFFILIATED WITH THE CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT
- 21 WOULD BE ABLE TO CLOSE THE CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT EXCEPT FOR OUTSTANDING
- 22 OBLIGATIONS THAT ARE MORE THAN 5 YEARS OLD;
- 23 (II) THERE ARE NO CURRENT OFFICERS APPOINTED AND SERVING
- 24 IN CONNECTION WITH THE CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT; OR
- 25 (III) OTHER EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST TO JUSTIFY
- 26 CLOSING THE ACCOUNT.

- 1 (2) THE CLOSING OF A CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT BY ACTION OF THE STATE 2 BOARD DOES NOT LIMIT THE RIGHT OF:
- 3 (I) THE STATE BOARD OR THE STATE PROSECUTOR TO PURSUE
- 4 ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST FORMER OFFICERS OR THE CANDIDATE
- 5 AFFILIATED WITH THE CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT; OR
- 6 (II) A CREDITOR TO BRING AN ACTION AGAINST A FORMER
- 7 OFFICER OR THE CANDIDATE AFFILIATED WITH THE CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2001.
