13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in every law, executive 9 order, rule, regulation, policy, or document created by any official, employee, or unit of 10 this State, Salisbury State University is renamed Salisbury University as provided in 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the publishers of the
- 13 Annotated Code of Maryland, subject to the approval of the Department of Legislative
- 14 Services, shall correct any statutory reference that is rendered incorrect by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
- 16 construed to effect any substantive rights or obligations of this entity that exist as of
- 17 the effective date of this Act. Such rights and obligations may be enforced by or
- 18 against these entities using the entity name in which the right or obligation was
- 19 created. This Act does not affect the validity of any rule, regulation, policy, directive,
- 20 permit, proposal, form, plan, contract, appropriation, grant, property interest,
- 21 administrative or judicial proceeding, right to sue and be sued, mission statement,
- 22 bond or other evidence of indebtedness, or any other duty or responsibility associated
- 23 with, or any other matter pending before, this entity, all of which shall continue in 24 effect.
- 25 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 July 1, 2001.
