## 2 State Procurement - Electronic Transactions

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing primary procurement units of State government to
- 4 conduct certain procurement transactions by electronic means; providing that
- 5 bidding on a contract solicited by electronic means constitutes consent to
- 6 conduct certain transactions by electronic means; authorizing the charge of
- 7 reasonable fees for certain electronic transactions; and generally relating to
- 8 electronic transactions in procurement contracts.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 16 Article - State Finance and Procurement

17 13-226.

- 18 (A) UNLESS OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY LAW, A PRIMARY PROCUREMENT
- 19 UNIT MAY CONDUCT ALL OR ANY PART OF A PROCUREMENT TRANSACTION,
- 20 INCLUDING SOLICITATION, BIDDING, AWARD, EXECUTION, OR ADMINISTRATION OF A
- 21 CONTRACT, BY ELECTRONIC MEANS AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 21 OF THE COMMERCIAL
- 22 LAW ARTICLE.
- 23 (B) BIDDING ON A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT BY ELECTRONIC MEANS SHALL
- 24 CONSTITUTE CONSENT BY THE BIDDER TO CONDUCT BY ELECTRONIC MEANS ALL
- 25 ELEMENTS OF THE PROCUREMENT TRANSACTION WHICH THE UNIT AGREES TO
- 26 CONDUCT BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

- 1 (C) (1) A UNIT UTILIZING ELECTRONIC MEANS TO CONDUCT ELEMENTS OF
- 2 A PROCUREMENT TRANSACTION OR A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FURNISHING TO THE
- 3 STATE ELECTRONIC MEANS FOR CONDUCTING ELEMENTS OF A PROCUREMENT
- 4 TRANSACTION MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE TO THE BIDDER FOR THE USE OF
- 5 THE ELECTRONIC MEANS.
- 6 (2) NO FEE MAY BE CHARGED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
- 7 APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 June 1, 2001.
