- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (1) A licensee or any person to whom a licensee has transferred a license under
- 19 subsection (i) of this section shall have in possession the tidal fish license AND ANY
- 20 VALID APPLICATION TO TRANSFER THE COMMERCIAL TIDAL FISH LICENSE
- 21 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR A TEMPORARY TRANSFER whenever engaged
- 22 in any licensed activity. The licensee or any person to whom a licensee has transferred
- 23 a license under subsection (i) of this section shall allow any police officer to inspect
- 24 the license AND ANY APPLICABLE APPLICATION TO TRANSFER THE COMMERCIAL
- 25 TIDAL FISH LICENSE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR A TEMPORARY
- 26 TRANSFER, to conduct searches as authorized in Subtitle 12 of this title, and to
- 27 inspect books, statements, and accounts as authorized in § 4-206(b) of this title.

- $1\,$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 2001.
