# 17 (a) A person may not knowingly remove or attempt to remove a firearm,18 CHEMICAL SPRAY, OR BATON from the possession of another person if:

19 (1) The other person is lawfully acting within the course and scope of 20 employment; and

21 (2) The person has knowledge or reason to know that the other person is 22 employed as:

- 23 (i) A law enforcement officer who, in an official capacity, is
  24 authorized by law to make arrests;
- 25 (ii) A sheriff, deputy sheriff, or assistant sheriff; or

1 (iii) An employee of the Division of Correction, the Patuxent 2 Institution, the Division of Pretrial Detention and Services, the Division of Parole and 3 Probation, any county jail or detention center, or any booking facility.

4 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is 5 subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than 10 years 6 or both.

7 (c) A sentence imposed under this section may be imposed separate from and 8 consecutive to or concurrent with a sentence for any offense based on the act or acts 9 establishing the offense under this section.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 11 effect October 1, 2001.
