## 1 **Article - Public Utility Companies** 2 8-205. 3 IN THIS SECTION, "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" MEANS AN (A) (1) 4 ORGANIZED ACTIVITY, PROGRAM, OR CAMPAIGN TO COMMUNICATE BY TELEPHONE 5 WITH RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND IN ORDER TO: SELL, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES; 6 (I) 7 (II)ATTEMPT TO SELL, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES: 8 (III)OFFER OR ATTEMPT TO OFFER A GIFT OR PRIZE: 9 (IV) CONDUCT OR ATTEMPT TO CONDUCT A POLL; OR 10 (V) REQUEST OR ATTEMPT TO REQUEST SURVEY INFORMATION, IF 11 THE RESULTS OF THE SURVEY WILL BE USED DIRECTLY TO SOLICIT PERSONS TO 12 PURCHASE, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES. "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" INCLUDES THE ACT OF MANAGING, 13 14 DIRECTING, OR SUPERVISING AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN TELEPHONE 15 SOLICITATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO: 16 (B) 17 <del>(1)</del> A UNIT OF FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT; OR A PERSON WHO HAS A PREEXISTING BUSINESS OR PERSONAL 18 (2)19 RELATIONSHIP WITH, OR THE CONSENT OF, THE PERSON WHO IS THE RECIPIENT OF 20 THE TELEPHONE SOLICITATION. IF THE TELEPHONE SERVICE OR EQUIPMENT OF A PERSON ENGAGED IN 21 22 TELEPHONE SOLICITATION ALLOWS THAT PERSON TO CHOOSE TO RESTRICT OR 23 DISPLAY THE TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO THE 24 RECIPIENT OF A TELEPHONE SOLICITATION, THE PERSON MAY NOT: INTENTIONALLY USE ANY DEVICE OR METHOD TO BLOCK THE 26 TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO A RECIPIENT; OR 27 TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION TO PREVENT OR CONTROL THE (2) 28 TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO A RECIPIENT. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 29 30 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:

FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000; AND

FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2001.
