BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Public Utility Companies** 17 8-205. IN THIS SECTION, "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" MEANS AN 18 (A) (1) 19 ORGANIZED ACTIVITY, PROGRAM, OR CAMPAIGN TO COMMUNICATE BY TELEPHONE 20 WITH RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND IN ORDER TO: 21 SELL, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES; (I) 22 ATTEMPT TO SELL, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES; (II)

OFFER OR ATTEMPT TO OFFER A GIFT OR PRIZE;

SENATE BILL 79 1 (V) REQUEST OR ATTEMPT TO REQUEST SURVEY INFORMATION, IF 2 THE RESULTS OF THE SURVEY WILL BE USED DIRECTLY TO SOLICIT PERSONS TO 3 PURCHASE, LEASE, OR RENT GOODS OR SERVICES. "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" INCLUDES THE ACT OF MANAGING, 5 DIRECTING, OR SUPERVISING AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN TELEPHONE 6 SOLICITATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO: 7 (B) 8 A UNIT OF FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT; OR (1) (2) A PERSON WHO HAS A PREEXISTING BUSINESS OR PERSONAL 10 RELATIONSHIP WITH, OR THE CONSENT OF, THE PERSON WHO IS THE RECIPIENT OF 11 THE TELEPHONE SOLICITATION. 12 (C) IF THE TELEPHONE SERVICE OR EQUIPMENT OF A PERSON ENGAGED IN 13 TELEPHONE SOLICITATION ALLOWS THAT PERSON TO CHOOSE TO RESTRICT OR 14 DISPLAY THE TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO THE 15 RECIPIENT OF A TELEPHONE SOLICITATION, THE PERSON MAY NOT: INTENTIONALLY USE ANY DEVICE OR METHOD TO BLOCK THE 17 TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO A RECIPIENT; OR TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION TO PREVENT OR CONTROL THE 18 (2) 19 TRANSMISSION OF THE PERSON'S TELEPHONE NUMBER TO A RECIPIENT. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 20 (D) 21 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO: 22 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000; AND

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000.
