A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2                           **State Highway Administration - POW/MIA Flag - Rest Areas, Welcome**  
3                           **Centers, and Exhibit Centers**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that the State Highway Administration ensure that a  
5     certain POW/MIA flag is flown year round at certain rest areas, welcome  
6     centers, and exhibit centers; defining a certain term; and generally relating to  
7     the POW/MIA flag and rest areas, welcome centers, and exhibit centers.

8 BY adding to  
9     Article - Transportation  
10    Section 8-651  
11    Annotated Code of Maryland  
12    (1993 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

13     SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15                           **Article - Transportation**

16 8-651.

17     (A)     IN THIS SECTION, "POW/MIA FLAG" MEANS THE POW/MIA FLAG OF THE  
18 NATIONAL LEAGUE OF FAMILIES OF AMERICAN PRISONERS AND MISSING IN  
19 SOUTHEAST ASIA.

20     (B)     THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE POW/MIA FLAG IS  
21 FLOWN YEAR ROUND AT EACH REST AREA, WELCOME CENTER, AND EXHIBIT CENTER  
22 UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION'S JURISDICTION WITHIN STATE HIGHWAY  
23 RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

24     SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
25 October 1, 2001.
