SENATE BILL 93 Article - State Personnel and Pensions 2 23-308. (a) In the year of retirement, a member of the Teachers' Pension System may 4 purchase credit for eligibility service [of up to 10 years] for periods of employment 5 described in subsection (g) of this section for which the member is not otherwise 6 entitled to service credit. [To] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 23-308.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, TO purchase (b) 8 service credit under this section, a member must: (1)complete and file a claim for the service credit with the Board of 10 Trustees on the form that the Board of Trustees provides; and (2)pay to the Board of Trustees an amount equal to the annuity reserve 12 and pension reserve required to fund the additional allowance. (c) A member may pay the amount required by subsection (b) of this section: on an installment basis by contributing at least 2% of earnable (1)15 compensation per year; or by transferring, on written request to the Board of Trustees, any (2)prior contributions to a voluntary retirement benefit, less any costs of administering 18 that benefit. (d) A member who transfers contributions under subsection (c)(2) of this 20 section may not transfer contributions qualifying under § 403(b) of the Internal 21 Revenue Code. A member who elects to make payments under subsection (c) of this section (e) 23 and who retires before completing the payments required to purchase this service 24 credit: is entitled to receive the service credit purchased before the date of (1)26 retirement; or may pay at the time of retirement the amount necessary to receive (2)28 full credit. The surviving spouse of a member who elects to make payments under (f) 30 subsection (c) of this section may pay for the appropriate final adjustment if: (1)the member dies while actively employed as a member; and the deceased member's service qualifies for a death benefit under § (2)29-206 of this article. A member may only purchase service credit under this section for (g) 35 employment:

(H) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SERVICE CREDIT IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT
 SYSTEM OR TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM THAT A MEMBER MAY PURCHASE UNDER
 THIS SECTION AND § 23-308.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT EXCEED 10 YEARS.

15 (A) FOR PERIODS OF EMPLOYMENT AS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS'
16 RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM FOR WHICH THE
17 MEMBER IS NOT OTHERWISE ENTITLED TO SERVICE CREDIT, A MEMBER OF THE
18 TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM MAY PURCHASE CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AS
19 PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

20 (B) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SERVICE CREDIT IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT
21 SYSTEM OR TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM THAT A MEMBER MAY PURCHASE UNDER
22 THIS SECTION AND § 23-308 OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT EXCEED 10 YEARS.

23 (C) A MEMBER WHO PURCHASES SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION MAY
24 NOT PURCHASE SERVICE CREDIT FOR ANY PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT DURING WHICH
25 THE MEMBER PARTICIPATED IN THE OPTIONAL RETIREMENT PROGRAM.

26 (D) TO PURCHASE SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION, A MEMBER MUST:

27 (1) COMPLETE A CLAIM FOR THE SERVICE CREDIT AND FILE IT WITH
28 THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROVIDES;
29 AND

30 (2) PAY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-HALF
31 OF THE ANNUITY RESERVE AND ONE-HALF OF THE PENSION RESERVE REQUIRED TO
32 FUND THE ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect34 July 1, 2001.
