16 (A) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL HAVE A MANDATORY GUN SAFETY

17 EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT IS GIVEN IN A PLANNED AND SEQUENTIAL MANNER,

18 KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12, AS PART OF THE INSTRUCTION IN HEALTH

19 EDUCATION.

# 1 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR THE 2 <u>ADMINISTRATION OF THE</u> GUN SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM.

3 (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL:

4 (1) DEVELOP A GUN SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM WITH A 5 CURRICULUM:

6 (I) APPROPRIATE TO THE DEMOGRAPHICS AND NEEDS OF EACH 7 SCHOOL SYSTEM IN THE STATE; AND

8 (II) UTILIZING MULTIPLE RESOURCES FOR CREATION;

9 (2) SUBMIT THE GUN SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM TO THE 10 DEPARTMENT FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO IMPLEMENTATION; AND

11(3)REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH12SCHOOL YEAR ON THE STATUS OF THE GUN SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2001.
