- 28 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 29 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 16-113(h), (i), and (j), respectively, of Article -

1 Transportation of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 2 16-113(i), (j), and (k), respectively. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 4 read as follows: 5 **Article - Transportation** 6 16-113. 7 In addition to the vision and other restrictions provided for in this (a) (1) subtitle, when it issues a driver's license, the Administration for good cause may 9 impose on the licensee: 10 Any restrictions suitable to the licensee's driving ability with 11 respect to the type of special mechanical control devices required on motor vehicles 12 that the licensee may drive; 13 An alcohol restriction which prohibits the licensee from driving (ii) 14 or attempting to drive a motor vehicle while having alcohol in the licensee's blood; and 15 Any other restrictions applicable to the licensee that the (iii) 16 Administration determines appropriate to assure the safe driving of a motor vehicle 17 by the licensee. 18 An alcohol restriction that prohibits the licensee from driving or 19 attempting to drive a motor vehicle while having alcohol in the licensee's blood may, 20 as described in subsections (b) and (g) of this section, include a restriction that 21 prohibits the licensee from driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle unless the 22 licensee is a participant in the Ignition Interlock System Program established under 23 § 16-404.1 of this title. 24 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II)2 OF THIS (H) (1) 25 PARAGRAPH, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL IMPOSE ON EACH LICENSEE UNDER THE 26 AGE OF 18 YEARS A RESTRICTION THAT PROHIBITS THE LICENSEE FROM DRIVING A 27 MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS. THE RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF (II)29 THIS PARAGRAPH: SHALL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE THE LICENSE IS 30 1. 31 ORIGINALLY ISSUED UNTIL THE 181ST DAY AFTER THE LICENSE WAS ISSUED; AND DOES NOT APPLY TO A PASSENGER WHO IS A SPOUSE. 32 33 DAUGHTER, SON, STEPDAUGHTER, STEPSON, SISTER, BROTHER, STEPSISTER, OR 34 STEPBROTHER OF THE LICENSEE. 35 A POLICE OFFICER MAY ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS (2)36 SUBSECTION ONLY AS A SECONDARY ACTION WHEN THE POLICE OFFICER DETAINS A 37 DRIVER FOR A SUSPECTED VIOLATION OF ANOTHER PROVISION OF THE CODE.
