A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Baltimore County The Community Learning
 Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$400,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Islamic
- 6 Society of Baltimore, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 7 prohibiting the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds and the matching
- 8 fund for religious purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds,
- 9 subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund;
- and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 15 County The Community Learning Center Loan of 2001 in the total principal amount
- 16 equal to the lesser of (i) \$400,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 17 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 18 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 19~ of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with $\S\S$ 8-117 through
- 20 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Islamic
- 30 Society of Baltimore, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 31 planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a building, to be located at

- 1 6600 Johnnycake Road in Baltimore, Maryland, to be used for a community learning 2 center.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- $8\,$ purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 9 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 10 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 12 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 13 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 14 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 15 The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 16 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 17 presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of
- 18 the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 19 (6) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 20 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the
- 21 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of
- 22 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or
- 23 department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board
- 24 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none
- 25 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
- 26 purpose prohibited by this Act.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 June 1, 2001.
