NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN 4 ORDER AWARDING CHILD SUPPORT TO AN UNMARRIED CHILD WHO IS ENROLLED IN 5 AT LEAST 4 UNITS OF CREDIT IN A PROGRAM AT A SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL 6 CONTINUE TO BE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE FIRST TO OCCUR OF THE FOLLOWING 7 EVENTS: 8 (I) THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT MARRIES; 9 THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT GRADUATES FROM OR IS (II)10 NO LONGER ENROLLED IN SECONDARY SCHOOL; OR 11 (III) THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT ATTAINS THE AGE OF 19 12 YEARS. 13 (3) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PREVENT A COURT 14 FROM MODIFYING A CHILD SUPPORT AWARD AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
