- 15 (b) (1) [The Comptroller shall sell] IF contraband tobacco products ARE
- 16 seized under this title and forfeited [to a State institution, a nonprofit charitable
- 17 institution, a licensed cigarette wholesaler, or a licensed cigarette manufacturer],
- 18 THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISPOSE OF AND DESTROY THE CONTRABAND TOBACCO
- 19 PRODUCTS in the manner the Comptroller determines.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
