- 1 (J) "VEHICLE PARKING FACILITY" MEANS A CONTROLLED ENTRANCE AND
- 2 EXIT BUILDING, STRUCTURE, SURFACE LOT, AND OTHER FACILITY FOR PARKING
- 3 VEHICLES, FOR WHICH FEES OR CHARGES ARE ESTABLISHED FOR THE USE OF THE
