- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to maintain a safe
- 5 driving credit system for all licensees; requiring the Administration to award a
- 6 safe driving credit, up to a certain limit, to licensees who meet certain safe
- 7 driving standards; requiring the Administration to apply safe driving credits in
- 8 a certain manner to offset points assessed against a licensee <u>for certain</u>
- 9 <u>violations;</u> providing for the invalidation of a safe driving credit under certain

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAINTAIN A SAFE DRIVING CREDIT SYSTEM 21 FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, FOR EACH CALENDAR
 YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL AWARD A SAFE DRIVING CREDIT TO EACH
 INDIVIDUAL WHOSE DRIVING RECORD DOES NOT CONTAIN A SUSPENSION,
 REVOCATION, OR CONVICTION FOR A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 388, § 388A, OR §

7 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT MAINTAIN A BALANCE OF MORE THAN FIVE 8 SAFE DRIVING CREDITS.

9 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

(1) USE ACCUMULATED SAFE DRIVING CREDITS TO OFFSET AN
 EQUIVALENT NUMBER OF ACCUMULATED POINTS, IF ANY POINTS ACCUMULATED BY
 THE INDIVIDUAL, IF ANY, FOR ONE OR MORE MOVING VIOLATIONS THAT ARE NOT
 ASSESSED MORE THAN 2 POINTS PER VIOLATION UNDER § 16-402 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
 AND

15(2)APPLY THE SAFE DRIVING CREDITS TO THE CHRONOLOGICALLY16EARLIEST CONVICTION FOR WHICH POINTS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED AND ARE VALID.

17 (E) A SAFE DRIVING CREDIT AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
18 INVALIDATED IF THE ADMINISTRATION RECEIVES A NOTICE OF CONVICTION FOR A
19 VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 388, § 388A, OR § 388B OF THE CODE, § 21-902 OF THE
20 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, OR OF THE VEHICLE LAWS OR REGULATIONS OF THIS
21 STATE OR OF ANY LOCAL AUTHORITY OCCURRING DURING THE PERIOD FOR WHICH
22 THE SAFE DRIVING CREDIT WAS AWARDED.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2001.
