#### A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - The Foundation School

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$3,000,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Foundation
- 5 Schools, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for
- 6 disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee
- 7 provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance
- 8 and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 10 MARYLAND, That:
- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 13 George's County The Foundation School Loan of 2001 in a total principal amount
- 14 equal to the lesser of (i) \$3,000,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided
- 15 in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance,
- 16 sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the
- 17 Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117
- 18 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of
- 19 the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Foundation
- 29 Schools, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning,
- 30 design, construction, and capital equipping of a new Foundation School in Prince
- 31 George's County, to be used as a school for students with emotional disturbances.

### **SENATE BILL 261**

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 5
- Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the (5) 6 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 7 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 8 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

- 9 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind
- 10 contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 11 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to
- 14 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 15 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 16 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 18 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 19 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 June 1, 2001.
