SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 A responsible person is civilly liable to the merchant:
- 4 To restore the merchandise to the merchant or, if the merchandise is
- 5 not recoverable, has been damaged, or otherwise has lost all or part of its value, to
- 6 pay the merchant an amount equal to the merchant's stated sales price for the
- 7 merchandise;
- 8 To pay the merchant for any other actual damages sustained by the (2)
- 9 merchant, not including the loss of time or wages incurred in connection with the
- 10 apprehension or prosecution of the shoplifter or employee; and
- 11 Subject to the merchant's compliance with the procedures contained
- 12 in § 3-1303 of this subtitle, to pay the merchant a civil penalty equal to twice the
- 13 merchant's stated sales price for the merchandise, but not less than [\$50] \$100 nor
- 14 more than [\$500] \$1,000.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 16 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 17 on or application to a cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 19 effect October 1, 2001.
