- 1 (II) IN A BORDER EXTENDING 2 MILES OUTSIDE OF THE CERTIFIED 2 NOISE ZONE.
- 3 (C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE IS 3 YEARS.
- 4 (2) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY
- 5 THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE ON OCTOBER 1, 6 2001.
- 7 (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A 8 SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
- 9 (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES 10 ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
