11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2-309.

15 (d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense
16 allowance of \$1,000 per year and a salary of:

- 17 1. \$62,000 in calendar year 1999;
- 18 2. \$64,000 in calendar year 2000;
- 19 3. \$67,000 in calendar year 2001; and
- 20 4. \$70,000 in calendar year 2002 and thereafter.

21 (ii) The Sheriff:

- 22 1. Shall appoint an undersheriff or chief deputy sheriff,
23 [a]TWO deputy sheriff [major]MAJORS, two deputy sheriff captains, four deputy
24 sheriff lieutenants, four deputy sheriff sergeants, one administrative officer II sheriff,
25 one secretary sheriff, one fiscal associate II sheriff, and one fiscal clerk sheriff; and
