- 6 Pension Benefit after a certain date will apply to all members of the Law
- 7 Enforcement Officers' Pension System; and generally relating to the members of

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 A MEMBER OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM WHO DID

24 NOT ELECT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' MODIFIED

25 PENSION BENEFIT AS PROVIDED IN § 26-211 OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL RECEIVE EACH

- 26 BENEFIT ENHANCEMENT ADDED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2001 TO THE LAW
- 27 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' MODIFIED PENSION BENEFIT.

#### **SENATE BILL 300**

1 26-401. 2 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, on 3 retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal service 4 retirement allowance that equals the number of years of the member's creditable 5 service multiplied by 2% of the member's average final compensation. A member's normal service retirement allowance under paragraph 6 (2) 7 (1) of this subsection may not exceed 60% of the member's average final 8 compensation. 9 This paragraph applies only to a member who is not subject to (3) (i) 10 the Law Enforcement Officers' Modified Pension Benefit under Subtitle 2. Part II of 11 this title. 12 (ii) On retirement under this paragraph, the member is entitled to 13 receive a normal service retirement allowance that equals: 14 1. [2%] 2.3% of the member's average final compensation 15 multiplied by each year of the member's first 30 years of creditable service; and 1% of the member's average final compensation multiplied 16 2. 17 by each year of creditable service in excess of 30 years.
