19 20	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
21 22	(2) "CORE SERVICE AGENCY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 10-1201 OF THIS ARTICLE.
25	(3) "COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDER" MEANS A COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR AN INDIVIDUAL PRACTITIONER WHO CONTRACTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OR THE APPROPRIATE CORE SERVICE AGENCY.

(4) "ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL" MEANS A MEDICAID RECIPIENT OR AN

 CONSUMERS" PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE
 WASHINGTON-BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN AREA; AND

15(2)THE ANNUAL RATE OF CHANGE MAY NOT EXCEED A MAXIMUM RATE16 OF 5%.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 July 1, 2001.
