- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 **Article - Health Occupations**
- 13 15-102.
- 14 A physician assistant may not practice within the scope of practice of any
- 15 of the following health occupations authorized under this article:
- 16 (1) ANESTHESIOLOGY;
- 17 (2) Nursing;
- [(2)]Optometry; 18 (3)
- 19 Physical therapy; or [(3)](4)
- Psychology. 20 [(4)](5)
- 21 This title does not limit the right of an individual to practice a health
- 22 occupation that the individual is authorized to practice under this article.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2001.
