- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ASSOCIATION OF
- 19 MARYLAND HOSPITALS AND HEALTH SYSTEMS AND THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION
- 20 OF HOSPITAL SECURITY AND SAFETY DIRECTORS, SHALL DEVELOP A UNIFORM
- 21 SECURITY CODE FOR HOSPITALS.
- 22 (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 23 UNIFORM SECURITY CODE.
- 24 (C) EACH HOSPITAL IN MARYLAND SHALL IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF
- 25 THE UNIFORM SECURITY CODE FOR HOSPITALS WITHIN 2 YEARS OF THE ADOPTION
- 26 OF THE REGULATIONS BY THE SECRETARY.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 October 1, 2001.
