- 1 Each fiscal year, the Board of Trustees shall increase the adjustment (2) 2 received by the retiree or the beneficiary as of July 1, [1999] 2001, by multiplying the 3 adjustment by a fraction that has: (i) as its numerator, the consumer price index for the calendar year 5 ending December 31 of the preceding fiscal year; and as its denominator, the consumer price index for the calendar 6 (ii) 7 year ending December 31, [1998]2000. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
