At any time after 30 days from the mailing of the statement and 16 17 notice, the collector shall cause to be published, 4 times, once a week for 4 successive 18 weeks in 1 or more newspapers that have a general circulation in the county in which 19 the property is located, a notice that the property will, on the date and at the place 20 named in the notice, be sold at public auction. 21 In Frederick County, Garrett County, Kent County, and Queen Anne's 22 County, the notice shall be published 3 times, once a week for 3 successive weeks. IN BALTIMORE CITY, 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE SALE, THE NOTICE 23 (3) (I) 24 SHALL BE: 1. PUBLISHED TWO TIMES, ONCE PER WEEK IN ALTERNATE

POSTED ON THE CITY'S WEBSITE.
