BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 4 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 5 8-301.1. IN THIS SECTION, "FESTIVAL" MEANS THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS BEER AND 6 (A) 7 WINE FESTIVAL. 8 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS. THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL 9 (C) 10 FESTIVAL (ABWF) (AWF) LICENSE. (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, AN 11 12 APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE SHALL BE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING 13 STATE RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, STATE CLASS 3 WINERY LICENSE, 14 OR STATE CLASS 4 LIMITED WINERY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE. 15 A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSEE SHALL: (E) 16 (1)ONLY DISPLAY AND SELL: 17 <del>(I)</del> WINE: THAT IS: 18 <u>(1)</u> 19 1. (I) MANUFACTURED AND PROCESSED IN ANY STATE; 20 2. WHO BREWS LESS THAN 60,000 BARRELS OF BEER 26 ANNUALLY; AND 27 WHOSE PRODUCT IS DISTRIBUTED IN THE STATE AT THE

- 30 ON OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS

28 TIME THE APPLICATION IS FILED:

- 1 (3) DISPLAY AND SELL WINE THAT IS MANUFACTURED AND PROCESSED
- 2 IN ANY STATE AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES ON THE
- 3 DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE FESTIVAL.
- 4 (F) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL FESTIVAL
- 5 LICENSE FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A
- 6 DIFFERENT CLASS OR NATURE.
- 7 (G) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD:
- 8 (1) MAY ESTABLISH THE LICENSE FEE;
- 9 (2) MAY SELECT ONE WEEKEND, FRIDAY THROUGH SUNDAY INCLUSIVE,
- 10 ANNUALLY FOR THE FESTIVAL PROVIDED THAT THE WEEKEND THAT IS SELECTED
- 11 DOES NOT OCCUR WITHIN 14 DAYS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE MARYLAND WINE
- 12 FESTIVAL:
- 13 (3) SHALL CHOOSE A LOCATION IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS FOR THIS
- 14 FESTIVAL THAT IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE; AND
- 15 (4) SHALL ASSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE FESTIVAL IS THE
- 16 PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER AND WINE.
- 17 (H) (1) PRODUCTS DISPLAYED AND SOLD SHALL BE:
- 18 (I) INVOICED TO THE FESTIVAL LICENSE HOLDER BY A LICENSED
- 19 STATE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY; AND
- 20 (II) DELIVERED TO THE FESTIVAL FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES
- 21 OF THE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY.
- 22 (2) WHENEVER A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE IS ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 23 SECTION, HOLDERS OF WHOLESALE, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY LICENSES MAY
- 24 ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE
- 25 TO DELIVER BEER AND WINE 2 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND TO
- 26 ACCEPT RETURNS 2 DAYS AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE, OF THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL
- 27 LICENSE.
- 28 (I) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD SHALL ADOPT
- 29 REGULATIONS FOR CARRYING OUT THIS SECTION.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 June 1, 2001 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of
- 32 the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by
- 33 three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General
- 34 Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective for
- 35 a period of 2 years from June 1, 2001 and, at the end of May 31, 2003 the 2-year
- 36 period, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 37 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
