## 2 Maryland Uniform Electronic Transactions Act - Scope

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the provisions of the Maryland Uniform Electronic
- 4 Transactions Act from modifying, limiting, or superseding certain provisions of
- 5 the federal Electronic Signatures in Global and National Commerce Act;
- 6 exempting certain notices of product recall or material failure of a product,
- 7 certain documents that accompany toxic or dangerous materials, and
- 8 transactions governed by certain laws governing family law from the Maryland
- 9 Uniform Electronic Transactions Act; repealing provisions of the Maryland
- 10 Uniform Electronic Transactions Act that exempt certain records from the scope
- of the Act and allow governmental agencies to adopt certain regulations;
- defining certain terms; specifying that the provisions of this Act are intended by
- the General Assembly to be consistent with a certain federal act; and generally
