3 **SENATE BILL 406** 1 OPERATOR OF A CHILD CARE CENTER OR FAMILY DAY CARE HOME DESIGNATING 2 THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION AS A "DRUG FREE 3 ZONES ZONE". A MAP APPROVED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE REVISED FROM 16 (2) 17 TIME TO TIME BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY. THE ORIGINAL OF EVERY MAP APPROVED OR REVISED UNDER THIS 18 19 SECTION, OR A TRUE COPY, SHALL BE FILED WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY 20 AND SHALL BE MAINTAINED AS AN OFFICIAL RECORD OF THE MUNICIPALITY OR 21 COUNTY. 22 THIS SECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE PROSECUTION FROM 23 INTRODUCING OR RELYING UPON ANY OTHER EVIDENCE OR TESTIMONY TO 24 ESTABLISH ANY ELEMENT OF THIS OFFENSE. 25 THIS SECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE USE OR ADMISSIBILITY OF 26 A MAP OR DIAGRAM OTHER THAN THE ONE WHICH HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE 27 MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY. **Article - Family Law** 28 29 5-501. "Child care center" means an agency, institution, or establishment

"Child care center" does not include: 6 (3) 7 a nonpublic kindergarten in which an instructional program is (i) 8 offered or provided for children who are at least 5 years old; 9 a nonpublic elementary school in which an instructional (ii) 10 program is offered or provided for children who are in grades 1 through 8; (iii) a child care home, a child care institution, or other child care 12 facility that offers or provides a residential placement for a child and is established, 13 licensed, or registered under this subtitle, Article 83C of the Code, or Title 10 of the 14 Health - General Article; or 15 a family day care home that is required to be registered or is (iv) 16 registered under this subtitle.
