BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 Article - Tax - General 15 13-841. The Comptroller shall sell contraband tobacco products seized 16 (I) under this title and forfeited to a State institution, a nonprofit charitable institution, 18 a licensed cigarette wholesaler, or a licensed cigarette manufacturer in the manner 19 the Comptroller determines. THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE PROCEEDS FROM 20 21 THE SALE OF CONTRABAND TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO THE MARYLAND HEALTH CARE 22 FOUNDATION, ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 20, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE HEALTH -23 GENERAL ARTICLE TO USE FOR TOBACCO CESSATION PROGRAMS. The Comptroller shall sell at public auction a conveyance that is 24 (2)25 seized under this title in connection with contraband tobacco products and forfeited.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
