2 **Baltimore City - Board of Liquor License Commissioners - Appeals**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Circuit Court for Baltimore City to affirm a certain
4 decision of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners involving an alcoholic
5 beverages license or adult-entertainment license if the court finds sufficient
6 evidence in a certain record; providing for the effective date of this Act; and
7 generally relating to decisions of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for
8 Baltimore City.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

18 (e) (5) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE CIRCUIT COURT IN A PETITION FOR
19 JUDICIAL REVIEW SHALL AFFIRM A DECISION OF THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE
20 COMMISSIONERS IF:

21 (I) FOLLOWING A PUBLIC HEARING, THE BOARD IMPOSES A FINE
22 ON OR REVOKES OR SUSPENDS AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OR

1 ADULT-ENTERTAINMENT LICENSE FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE, BOARD
2 RULES, OR ADULT-ENTERTAINMENT RULES; AND

3 (II) THE CIRCUIT COURT FINDS SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF THE
4 VIOLATION IN THE RECORD OF THE PUBLIC HEARING.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
