- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (A) In this title, "property tax" includes a taxing district tax.
- 6 (B) (1) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS TITLE, PROPERTY NEWLY ANNEXED INTO A 7 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION DURING A PERIOD SHALL BE TREATED AS INITIALLY
- 8 ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL FOR THAT PERIOD.

- 12 corporation property tax on real property that, during the period from January 1 to
- 13 March 30, both inclusive, is completed or otherwise is initially added to the tax roll. If
- 14 imposed, the tax shall be for the 3-month period from April 1 to June 30, both
- 15 inclusive, at 25% of the annual county or municipal corporation tax rate that is in
- 16 effect for that taxable year.
- 17 (b) The county or municipal corporation property tax imposed under this 18 section is due on the later of:
- 19 (1) April 1 of the taxable year; or
- 20 (2) the date that the tax bill is received or reasonably should have been 21 received or is available.
- 22 (c) County or municipal corporation property tax imposed under this section 23 may be paid without interest or penalty on or before 30 days after the date the tax bill 24 is mailed or made available.
