CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Code - Compensation of Election Judges - Harford County**

3 FOR the purpose of providing for the salary of the election judges in Harford County;  
4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the  
5 incumbent election judges in Harford County; and generally relating to the  
6 salary of the election judges in Harford County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article 33 - Election Code  
9 Section 10-205  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 33 - Election Code**

15 10-205.

16 (a) A local board may fix the compensation of election judges within the limits  
17 authorized for this purpose by the county's governing body.

18 (b) (1) In Allegany County, the compensation for each day actually served  
19 may not be less than:

20 (i) \$100 per day for each chief election judge; and

1 (ii) \$80 per day for every other election judge.

2 (2) In Baltimore City, the compensation for each election day actually  
3 served shall be:

4 (i) \$150 per day for each chief election judge; and

5 (ii) \$125 per day for every other election judge.

6 (3) In Baltimore County, the compensation for each election day actually  
7 served shall be:

8 (i) \$160 per day for each chief election judge; and

9 (ii) \$125 per day for every other election judge.

10 (4) In Calvert County, the compensation for each election day actually  
11 served shall be:

12 (i) \$125 per day for each chief election judge; and

13 (ii) \$100 per day for every other election judge.

14 (5) IN HARFORD COUNTY, THE COMPENSATION FOR EACH ELECTION  
15 DAY ACTUALLY SERVED SHALL BE:

16 (I) NOT LESS THAN \$160 PER DAY FOR EACH CHIEF ELECTION  
17 JUDGE; AND

18 (II) NOT LESS THAN \$125 PER DAY FOR EVERY OTHER ELECTION  
19 JUDGE.

20 [(5)] (6) (i) In Prince George's County, the compensation for each  
21 election day actually served shall be:

22 1. \$150 per day for two chief election judges; and

23 2. \$100 per day for every other election judge.

24 (ii) 1. In Prince George's County, except as provided under  
25 sub-subparagraph 2 of this subparagraph, election judges and alternate election  
26 judges shall receive \$25 as compensation for completing the course of instruction  
27 required under § 10-206 of this subtitle.

28 2. An election judge or alternate election judge may not  
29 receive the compensation authorized under this subparagraph if the election judge  
30 refuses to serve on an election day, unless the local board excuses the election judge.

31 [(6)] (7) (i) In Washington County, the compensation for each election  
32 day actually served shall be:
