14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18(A)(1)IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS19INDICATED.

20 (2) "ACCIDENT" MEANS AN OCCURRENCE THAT RESULTS IN PERSONAL 21 INJURY OR DEATH AND IS NOT THE RESULT OF A WILLFUL ACT BY A PARTY.

22 (3) "BENEVOLENT GESTURE" MEANS A STATEMENT, WRITING, OR ACT 23 THAT CONVEYS A SENSE OF SYMPATHY, COMPASSION, OR COMMISERATION.

(4) "FAMILY MEMBER" MEANS A SPOUSE, PARENT, GRANDPARENT,
STEPMOTHER, STEPFATHER, CHILD, GRANDCHILD, BROTHER, SISTER, HALF
BROTHER, HALF SISTER, ADOPTED CHILD OF A PARENT, OR SPOUSE'S PARENT OF AN
INDIVIDUAL.

(B) A BENEVOLENT GESTURE THAT RELATES TO THE PAIN, SUFFERING, OR
 DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT AND MADE TO THE
 INDIVIDUAL OR TO A FAMILY MEMBER OF THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE INADMISSIBLE
 AS EVIDENCE OF AN ADMISSION OF LIABILITY IN A CIVIL ACTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
6 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
7 on or application to any accident that occurs before the effective date of this Act.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2001.
