## Department of Natural Resources - Vessel Operation - Regulations

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the requirement that the Department of Natural

- 4 Resources adopt regulations that govern the numbering of vessels for
- 5 identification purposes so that each type or size vessel that complies with the
- 6 regulations may be operated in a certain manner; and generally relating to the
- 7 requirement of the Department to adopt vessel operation regulations requiring
- 8 the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations regarding the
- 9 operation of vessels so that each vessel of a type or size may be operated under
- 10 similar requirements as other vessels of that type or size; and generally relating
- 11 to the requirement that the Department adopt regulations governing the
- 12 <u>operation of vessels</u>.

### 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

5 (b) In order to protect the public safety, welfare, and recreational interests in 6 waters of the State, the Department may adopt a program relating to the placement 7 of buoys, mooring buoys, and other apparatus used to secure, berth, or moor vessels in 8 the waters of the State. The Department shall consult with any county affected by the 9 program.
