6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

10 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 11 INDICATED.

12 (2) "FUND" MEANS THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL13 CONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

(D) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO SUPPLEMENT COUNTY FUNDING FOR
PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AND PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS.

(E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF THE PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE STATE
 LOTTERY FUND AS REQUIRED UNDER § 9-120 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

22 (b) (1) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:
 (i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section; [and]
 (II) SUBJECT TO § 9-102.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, TO THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND CREATED UNDER § 5-202.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT TOTALING ONE-THIRD OF THE MONEY THAT REMAINS IN THE STATE LOTTERY FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF ALL OTHER LOTTERIES AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND
 [(ii)] (III) into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the [distribution under subsection (a) of this section] DISTRIBUTIONS UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION AND ITEM (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM" MEANS THE COLLECTION OF
6 PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS UNDER THE CONTROL
7 OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF
8 BALTIMORE CITY.

9 (B) THE SHARE OF PROCEEDS IN THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL
10 SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO WHICH AN
11 INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE UNDER THE

15 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY DISTRIBUTED UNDER §
16 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE ONLY FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS OR
17 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS THAT ARE APPROVED BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE
18 ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION.

(D) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED
TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS FOR USE AS
THE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED FOR STATE FUNDED PUBLIC SCHOOL
CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT
ANY OTHER DISTRIBUTION OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS TO PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

(E) ON OR BEFORE EACH MARCH 1, THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON
SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS
COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE A REPORT ON
THE ACTIVITIES DURING THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR OF THE MARYLAND PUBLIC
SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.
