3 FOR the purpose of reinstating a statutory veto previously granted the licensed

- 4 clinical marriage and family therapist member of the State Board of

- 7 counselors to provide services under certain supervision; authorizing the Board

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 (2) Submit an annual report to the Governor and the Secretary;

15 (4) Establish continuing education requirements for the counselors or 16 therapists currently certified or licensed by the Board;

family therapist votes, either in the affirmative or in the negative, on the proposed

	(4) The Board shall notify the Board of Examiners of Psychologists of the complaint in writing within 60 days of receipt of the complaint if an investigation of the supervising licensed psychologists is warranted.
	(5) The Board shall initiate disciplinary action against any licensed professional counselor who also registers as a psychology associate and violates any portion of this statute.
