1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

5 (j) (4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, <u>AND</u>
6 <u>EXCEPT WHERE EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST</u>, BEFORE A LICENSED
7 PREMISES IN BALTIMORE CITY THAT HAS BEEN CLOSED FOR AT LEAST 3
8 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS MAY BE REOPENED:

9 (I) THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL HOLD 10 A PUBLIC HEARING; AND

11 (II) THE LICENSEE SHALL OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD OF 12 LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS TO REOPEN.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2001.
