FOR the purpose of requiring in Baltimore City that before a licensed premises that has been closed for a certain period may reopen, the Board of Liquor License Commissioners shall hold a public hearing and the licensee shall obtain the approval of the Board; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages and licensed premises in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (j) (4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, 18 BEFORE A LICENSED PREMISES IN BALTIMORE CITY THAT HAS BEEN CLOSED FOR AT 19 LEAST 3 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS MAY BE REOPENED:
20 (I) THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL HOLD 21 A PUBLIC HEARING; AND

- 1 (II) THE LICENSEE SHALL OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD OF 2 LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS TO REOPEN.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 2001.
