1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Reopening of Licensed Premises**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring in Baltimore City that before a licensed premises that
4 has been closed for a certain period may reopen, the Board of Liquor License
5 Commissioners shall hold a public hearing and the licensee shall obtain the
6 approval of the Board; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages and licensed
7 premises in Baltimore City.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 10-301.

17 (j) (4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE,
18 BEFORE A LICENSED PREMISES IN BALTIMORE CITY THAT HAS BEEN CLOSED FOR AT
19 LEAST 3 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS MAY BE REOPENED:

20 (I) THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL HOLD
21 A PUBLIC HEARING; AND

1 (II) THE LICENSEE SHALL OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD OF
2 LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS TO REOPEN.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2001.
