- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Transportation
- 23 6-204.
- 24 (i) The Administration may acquire, construct, reconstruct, rehabilitate,
- 25 improve, maintain, lease as lessor or as lessee, repair, and operate either directly or
- 26 through State created private operating companies port facilities within its territorial
- 27 jurisdiction, including the dredging of ship channels and turning basins and the
- 28 filling and grading of land.

- 2 Under the authority granted by § 6-204(i) of this article, the Maryland Port
- 3 Administration [shall] MAY operate and maintain the port facility presently under
- 4 its jurisdiction at Cambridge, Maryland. The operation and maintenance may include
- 5 the leasing of the facility. The Maryland Port Administration may expend the
- 6 necessary funds for the development of the port facility at Cambridge. THE
- 7 ADMINISTRATION MAY SELL, TRANSFER, OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF THE FACILITY
- 8 IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-305 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT
- 9 ARTICLE.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2001.
