CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Creation of a State Debt - Talbot County - Oxford Community Services**
3 **Building**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed ~~\$300,000~~
5 ~~\$250,000~~ \$150,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of
6 Commissioners of the Town of Oxford for certain development or improvement
7 purposes; requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the
8 Maryland Historical Trust; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds,
9 subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund;
10 and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That:

13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Talbot
15 County - Oxford Community Services Building Loan of 2001 in a total principal
16 amount equal to the lesser of (i) ~~\$300,000~~ \$250,000 \$150,000 or (ii) the amount of the

1 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
2 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
3 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
4 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
5 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

6 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
7 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
8 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

9 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
10 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
11 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
12 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
13 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
14 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Commissioners of the Town
15 of Oxford (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design,
16 reconstruction, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of, and construction of an
17 addition to, a building located at 100 North Morris Street in Oxford, Maryland, for the
18 Oxford Community Services Building, which will include a handicap accessible
19 elevator, community meeting room, and public rest rooms.

20 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
21 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
22 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
23 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

24 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
25 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
26 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
27 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
28 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind
29 contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of
30 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
31 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
32 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to
33 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
34 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
35 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
36 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
37 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
38 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

39 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
40 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
41 its interest:

42 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
43 and

1 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
2 structures.

3 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land
4 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.

5 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
6 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable
7 to the Trust.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 June 1, 2001.
