A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Department of Natural Resources - Regional Boat Disposal Centers

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to develop
- 4 regional centers for the disposal of certain distressed vessels; requiring the
- 5 Department to pay a certain percentage of the cost of disposal and to require the
- 6 owner of the vessel to pay a certain percentage of the cost of disposal; declaring
- 7 certain findings and intent of the General Assembly; authorizing the
- 8 Department to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the
- 9 establishment of regional boat disposal centers.
- 10 BY adding to
- 11 Article Natural Resources
- 12 Section 8-721.2
- 13 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 14 (2000 Replacement Volume)
- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Natural Resources
- 18 8-721.2.
- 19 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT:
- 20 (1) THERE IS A GROWING PROBLEM OF INDIVIDUALS ABANDONING
- 21 THEIR VESSELS WHEN THE VESSELS ARE NO LONGER OPERATIONAL OR
- 22 SALVAGEABLE;
- 23 (2) ABANDONED VESSELS IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE ARE A HAZARD
- 24 TO NAVIGATION, A HAZARD TO THE ENVIRONMENT, AND AN IMPEDIMENT TO
- 25 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND
- 26 (3) THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS HAVE BEEN WORKING
- 27 TOGETHER TO ESTABLISH A PROCESS FOR REMOVING ABANDONED VESSELS FROM

- 1 THE WATERS OF THE STATE, HOWEVER, THE PROCESS IS BOTH CUMBERSOME AND 2 COSTLY.
- 3 (B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THIS SECTION TO:
- 4 (1) DEVELOP AN INCENTIVE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OWNS A
- 5 DISTRESSED VESSEL TO DISPOSE PROPERLY OF THE VESSEL; AND
- 6 (2) MINIMIZE THE NUMBER OF ABANDONED VESSELS IN THE WATERS 7 OF THE STATE.
- 8 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH REGIONAL CENTERS THAT 9 PROVIDE FOR THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF DISTRESSED VESSELS THAT ARE PRIVATELY 10 OWNED.
- 11 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY FOR 75% OF THE COST OF THE 12 DISPOSAL OF A VESSEL.
- 13 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE THE OWNER OF THE VESSEL TO 14 PAY THE REMAINING 25% OF THE COST OF THE DISPOSAL OF THE VESSEL.
- 15 (D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 16 SECTION.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2001.
