 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE NEW BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL
 COMMISSIONERS.

19(I)MAY NOT TRANSFER ANY OF THOSE REVENUES TO THE20GENERAL FUND; AND

(II) SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM THE
 REVENUES ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE
