4 person who while driving a motor vehicle during a single traffic incident exceeds

- 5 <u>the speed limit and commits at least a certain number of motor vehicle</u>
- 6 violations and causes the death of another person as a result of the person's

7 negligent driving of the motor vehicle; providing for certain penalties; specifying

8 certain violations to which the crime of homicide by aggressive driving applies;

9 providing for the assessment of points by the Motor Vehicle Administration for a

10 conviction for the crime of homicide by aggressive driving; defining a certain

11 term; and generally relating to establishing the crime of homicide by aggressive

12 driving.
