1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Clerks of Courts - Auditor's Report and Bonds - Recording and Indexing**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing requirements for the clerks of the circuit courts to
4 record and index an auditor's report as to disposition of the proceeds of a sale of
5 property, after ratification by a circuit court, and bonds given in any court
6 proceeding; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to
7 information required to be maintained by the clerks of the circuit courts.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) The clerk of a court shall:

4 (2) Make proper legible entries of all proceedings of the court and keep
5 them in well bound books or other permanent form;

7 [The clerks] EACH CLERK of [the] A circuit court [of a county shall record,
8 index, and maintain the following information when filed in the court:9 (1) An auditor's report of distribution of proceeds of a sale of real or
10 personal property if ratified by the court of which he is clerk;11 (2) All bonds of every nature and kind given in any proceeding in the
12 court; and13 (3) A] SHALL KEEP PERMANENTLY A test book containing the oaths of
14 office and signatures of every [person] INDIVIDUAL who takes the oath before the
15 clerk.16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 June 1, 2001.
