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## Circuit Courts - Funding of Law Clerks <del>and Rental of Space for Clerks of Court</del>

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to pay counties rent for certain space in

- 5 county facilities occupied by the clerks of the circuit courts, as provided in
- 6 certain agreements approved by the Board of Public Works; prohibiting an
- 7 agreement for rental from exceeding a certain amount and including certain
- 8 provisions; prohibiting a county from decreasing the space allocated to the clerk
- 9 of the circuit court; requiring each circuit court judge to have a law clerk
- 10 employed by the State; requiring certain appropriations to be included in the
- 11 State budget; requiring counties and Baltimore City to use the savings from this
- 12 Act for circuit court or related public safety purposes; requiring reports on
- 13 certain expenditures; providing for the <del>construction and</del> application of this Act;
- 14 and generally relating to State funding of circuit court operations.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

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18 (A) EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE SHALL HAVE ONE LAW CLERK, TO BE 19 EMPLOYED BY THE STATE.

(B) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO
EMPLOY ONE LAW CLERK FOR EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, AT A SALARY AND WITH
THE BENEFITS WITHIN A RANGE PROPOSED BY THE CONFERENCE OF CIRCUIT
JUDGES TO THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not relieve 26 any county, including Baltimore City, of its duty, before or after the effective date of 27 this Act, to provide space for the circuit court for the county and court related 28 agencies.

29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be 30 construed to assume any liability incurred by any county or Baltimore City in 31 connection with space occupied by the circuit court for the county or City or by a

32 court related agency.

33 SECTION 4. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

34 (1) Beginning in fiscal year 2002 and each fiscal year thereafter, each county 35 and Baltimore City shall use the local fiscal savings resulting from this Act solely to 36 increase local expenditures for circuit court or related public safety purposes;

1 (2) In fiscal years 2002 through 2009, each county and Baltimore City shall

2 report to the Department of Budget and Management on or before November 1 on

3 circuit court or related public safety expenditures to which the savings resulting from

4 this Act have been applied. The Department of Budget and Management shall report5 these expenditures to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals; and

6 (3) Circuit court or related public safety expenditures required under this 7 section shall be used to supplement and may not supplant existing local expenditures 8 for the same purpose.

9 SECTION 5. <u>3.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply 10 only to a law clerk hired on or after July 1, 2001 and not to a law clerk employed by 11 a circuit court judge on or before June 30, 2001.

12 SECTION 6. <u>4.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 13 effect July 1, 2001.

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
